

5 TIPS for teaching and engaging students with disabilities

Santa Barbara City College provides students a diverse learning environment that inspires curiosity and discovery, promotes global responsibility, and fosters opportunity for all.

DSPS is the designated agent of the college to approve reasonable accommodations for students with disabilities. Therefore, we want to remind you of the following best practices:

- 1. Maintain student *confidentiality*.
 - A student's disability status is considered confidential and must be maintained throughout all interactions
 - Please conduct all conversations related to a student's accommodations privately, rather than in front of the class
- 2. Acknowledge that disability is an aspect of *diversity*.
- 3. Provide equal access to instruction through a model of *shared responsibility* to include instructor, student and DSPS.
- 4. Implement *approved* accommodations per legal compliance.
- 5. Contact DSPS and the student if providing an accommodation is considered a *fundamental alteration* of the course.
 - A fundamental alteration is a change that is so significant that it invalidates or alters the essential nature of the course, program, etc.
